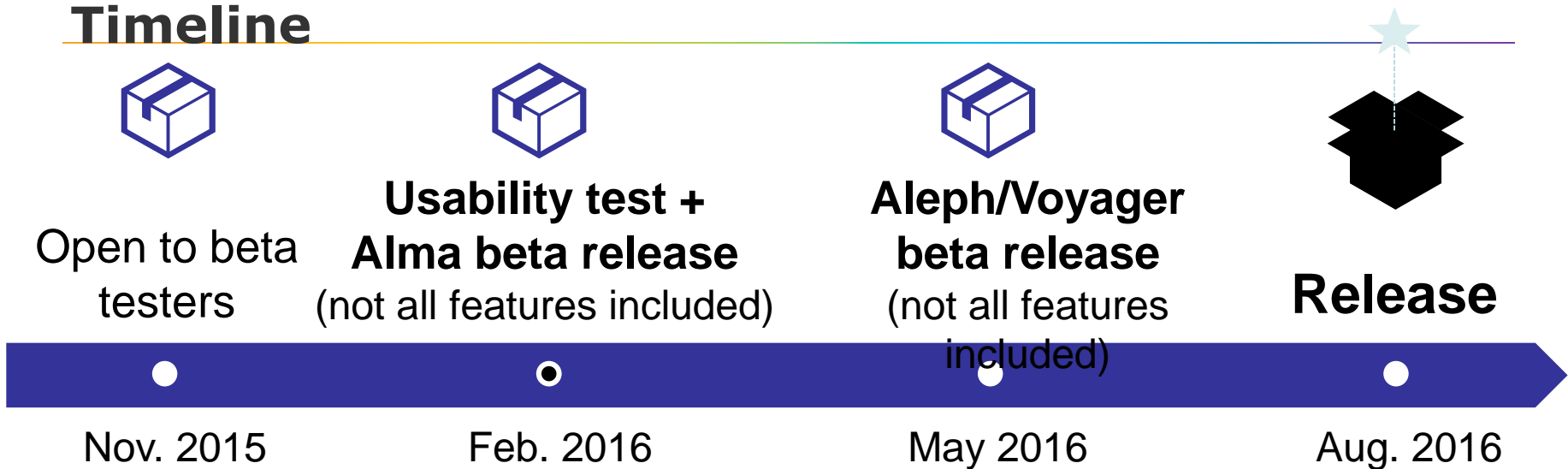

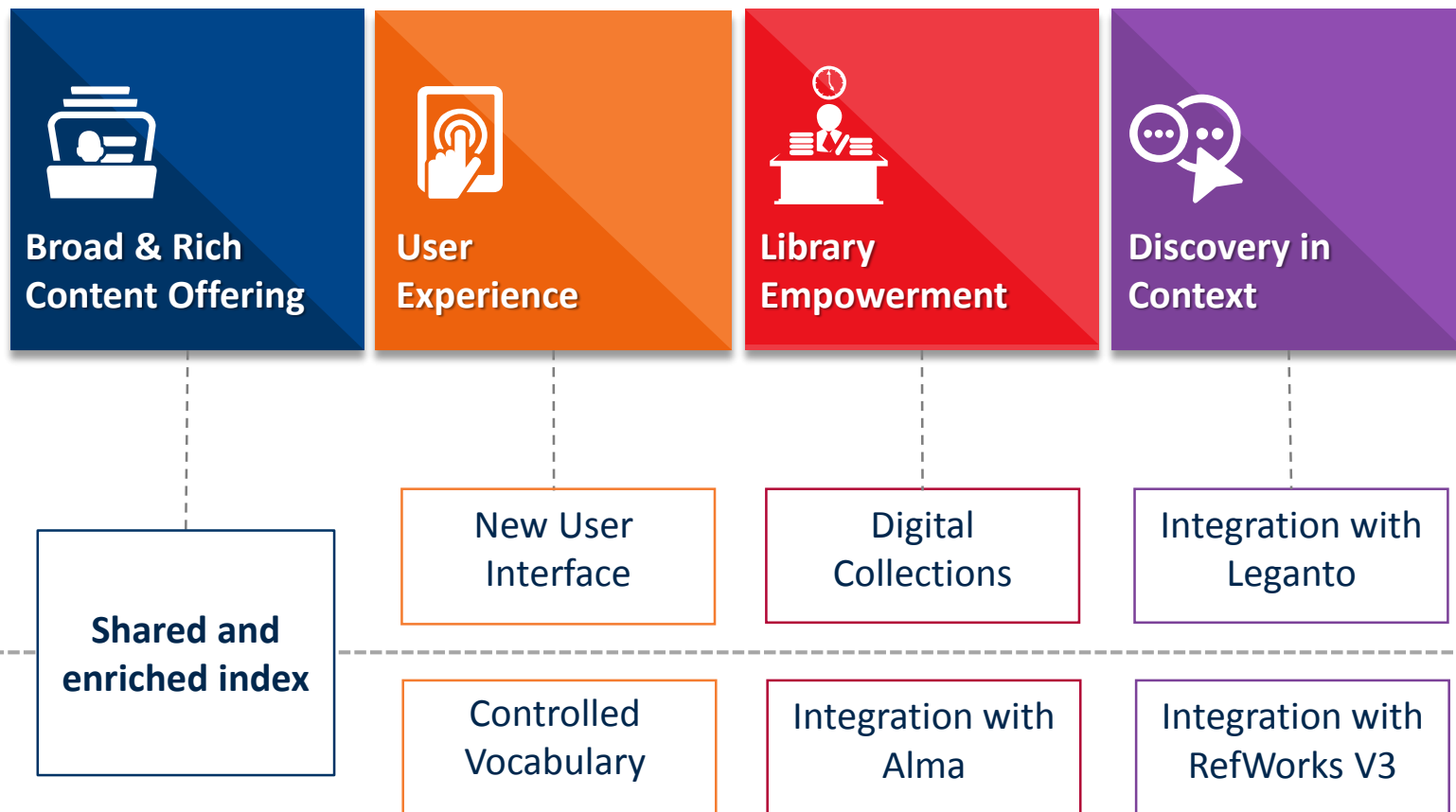
New Primo User Interface: Process & Rollout Timeline

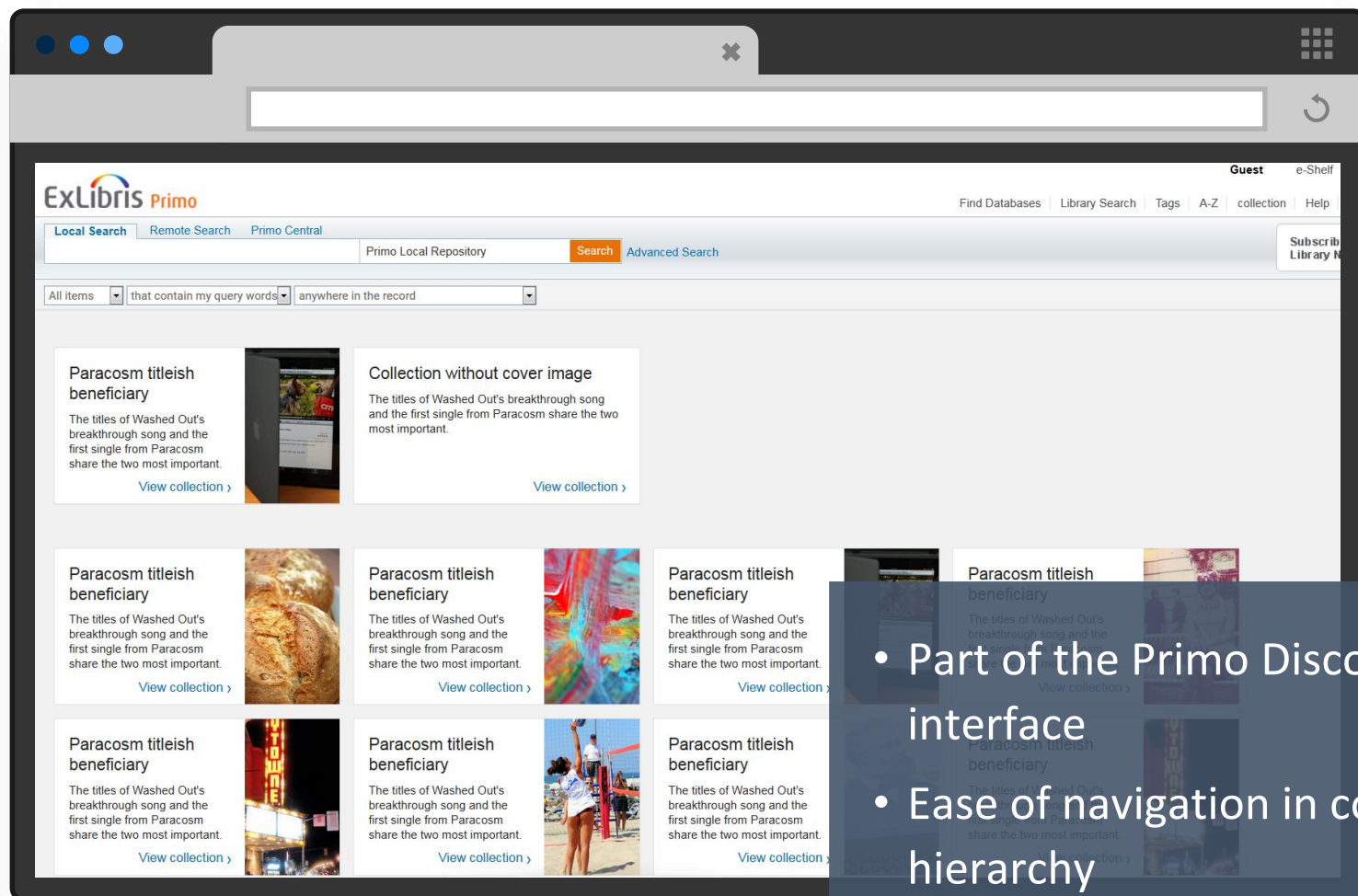

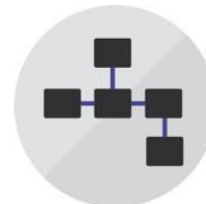
